RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries must be received no later than June 30th, 2023 in order to be included and announced in the parade.
2. **No Entry Fee** for non-profits, schools, churches. ALL OTHERS, Entry Fee \$25. Fees must be turned in with applications by June 30th
3. All entrants are asked to be at the line-up (Round Lick Church Parking Lots) no later than 2:00 p.m. on July 4th.
4. Horse/Donkey/Mule Entries: All horses, donkeys, mules or other riding animals must either wear a bag or device on rear to catch any excrements, or alternately riders may choose to pay a \$10 clean up fee per horse. Clean up fees must be turned in with applications by June 30th
5. No one will be allowed to tag onto the end of the parade line-up once the parade begins. Participants arriving after 2 p.m. will not be allowed to participate
