2. **No Entry Fee** for non-profits, schools, churches and non-business individuals. ALL OTHERS, Entry Fee \$20. Fees must be turned in with applications by July 2nd.
3. All entrants are asked to be at the line-up (Round Lick Church Parking Lots) no later than 3:00 p.m. on July 4th.
4. Horse/Donkey/Mule Entries: All horses, donkeys, mules or other riding animals must either wear a bag or device on rear to catch any excrements, or alternately riders may choose the pay a \$10 clean up fee per horse. Clean up fees must be turned in with applications by July 2nd
5. No one will be allowed to tag onto the end of the parade line-up once the parade begins. Participants arriving after 3 p.m. will not be allowed to participate
